### **Community**

Hilliard is a suburban, residential community located northwest of Columbus, Ohio. Encompassing approximately sixty square miles, the Hilliard City School District is among the fastest growing districts in the state. It is the eighth largest public school district in Ohio with 15,600 students and has met 26 of 26 performance indicators on the state report card. A large percentage of the students are college bound. The majority of the school district's over 80,000 residents are business, professional and blue-collar workers.

### **School**

Hilliard Bradley High School is a four-year comprehensive public school of 1500 students. There were no seniors during the 2009-2010 school year, Bradley's inaugural year. School is in session 183 days a year. The academic year is divided into two semesters with four nine-week grading periods. Class periods are fifty minutes in length.

### **Faculty**

Hilliard Bradley High School has 99 certificated professional staff. Of the certificated staff, 77 have earned advanced degrees.

### **Graduation Requirements**

Hilliard Bradley is a comprehensive secondary school that includes college preparatory, honors, Advanced Placement, dual enrollment, occupational, vocational, and adjustment programs. Passing all five sections of The Ohio Graduation Test is required of the students. Twenty-one units of credit are required for graduation. Those credits must include:

- English – 4 units
- Science – 3 units
- Mathematics – 3 units (4 units – class of 2014+)
- Social Studies – 3 units
- I.C.T. – 1/2 unit
- Financial Literacy – 1/2 unit (class of 2014+)
- Health/PE – 1 unit (students may waive PE credit if athlete)

### **Advanced Placement and Honors**

Advanced Placement courses are offered in English Literature and Composition, English Language and Composition, U.S. Government & Politics, U.S. History, European History, Chemistry, Physics, Calculus, Biology, French, German, Spanish and Computer Science. Honors courses are offered in English 9, English 10, Algebra 2, Science 9, Biology and Chemistry.

### **Post Secondary Enrollment Option**

The state sponsored dual enrollment option is available to all students who meet the requirements of respective post secondary institutions. In addition concurrent enrollment options are offered in English Literature, Statistics, U.S. Government, Physics, Chemistry, French, Spanish, Personal Finance and Marketing through Kenyon College (KAP), Columbus State Community College, Ohio Dominican University and Sinclair College.

### **Class Rank**

Class rank is determined by the G.P.A. The student with the highest G.P.A. is ranked first, second highest is ranked second, etc.
