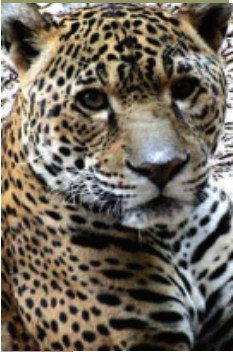


A Message from David Stewart, Principal:

Dear Bradley Family:



As Thanksgiving approaches, I am reminded of how much we have to be thankful for at Bradley HS. Our students continue to provide example after example of reasons to be proud of their talent, accomplishments, generosity, and service to their community.

Before I go into more detail about the most recent accomplishments of our students, let me first remind you that the end of the first quarter is an excellent time to intervene if your student is not experiencing the success that you would expect. The best opportunity to initiate this is on Parent/Teacher Conference Night on November 18 from 3:00 – 8:30 p.m. The first quarter grade reports of the 2010-2011 school year were recently distributed. If you have concerns about your student's performance, or if you just wish to have a conversation with his/her teacher, please consider scheduling a conference. If you would like to schedule a conference with one or more of your student's teachers, please use the form that is included with this newsletter to request a conference. To schedule your conferences you may mail the form in, send it to school with your student, or call 921-7420 (beginning Monday, November 11) to schedule your conferences by phone. The secretary who schedules the conferences will mail or email a confirmation to you with a specific time for your conference(s), or call you if the time is too short for the mail. Please keep in mind that we have a limited number of conference times, which fill quickly for some teachers, so please return your request as early as possible. Conference times will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Voicemail extensions have been included in past issue of *The Bradley Bulletin*, all of which are available on the Bradley website. In order to reach a teacher by phone, simply dial "921" and the four digit extension listed for that teacher. If you would prefer to use email, all teachers have the same email format. That format is: **firstname.lastname@hboe.org**

I continue to be amazed by the success of our students. You are already aware that both the Hilliard City Schools (Excellent with Distinction) and Hilliard Bradley High School (Excellent) received the highest possible ranking from the State of Ohio for the 2009-2010 school year. Additionally, we recently learned that Mariah Sasson (Commended Scholar) and Ilhan Dahir (National Achievement Scholar) were recently named as Bradley High School's first ever National Merit Scholars based on their performance on last year's Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) compared to other students across the nation.

As Fall slowly heads to Winter, it is a great time to reflect upon the success of the past few months. Our Fall sports teams are wrapping up immensely successful seasons, capped by Lauren Thai and Ashley Thai winning the Ohio State Doubles Tennis title, the first state title in any sport in Bradley High School history! Additionally, our Girls Tennis team finished fourth in the Ohio Tennis Coaches Association team competition. As of the time of this newsletter, the Boys and Girls Cross Country Teams are scheduled to appear in the Regional Cross Country Meet, and both our Girls Volleyball and Boys Soccer teams are still playing in their respective district tournaments.

In the Performing Arts, our Marching Band has continued to make its mark on Central Ohio, once again performing at Ohio Stadium and also qualifying for the OMEA State Band Contest. Our Choir recently learned that they have been chosen to perform the National Anthem at a Cleveland Cavaliers game in February. In our Orchestra program, Christy Showalter, Tom Watts, Lydia Stucki, Elisabeth Bonnell, and Thomas Kettman were selected to the elite Southeast Regional Suburban Orchestra. Finally, our Theater department recently completed three different productions, most notably Neil Simon's *Rumors*, which was a huge success!

Have a great Thanksgiving holiday season. I think it's clear that we have much to be thankful for at Bradley High School!

The school cafeteria will be open and serving a limited selection.

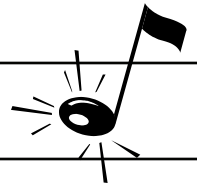

November 11, 2010 – The marching band will participate in the Hilliard Veterans Day parade.

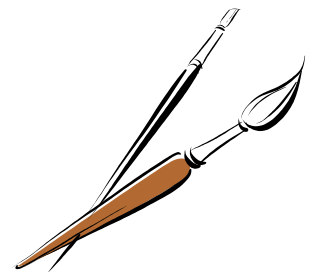
December, 2010 – The marching band will travel to Tampa, Florida to perform at the Outback Bowl.
