

A Message from David Stewart, Principal:

Dear Bradley Family:

As Thanksgiving approaches, I am reminded of how much we have to be thankful for at Bradley HS. Our students continue to provide example after example of reasons to be proud of their talent, accomplishments, generosity, and service to their community.

Before I go into more detail about the most recent accomplishments of our students, let me first remind you that the end of the first quarter is an excellent time to intervene if your student is not experiencing the success that you would expect. The best opportunity to initiate this is on Parent/Teacher Conference Night on November 18 from 3:00 – 8:30 p.m. The first quarter grade reports of the 2009-2010 school year were recently distributed. If you have concerns about your student's performance, or if you just wish to have a conversation with his/her teacher, please consider scheduling a conference. If you would like to schedule a conference with one or more of your student's teachers, please use the form that you received in the mail to request a conference. To schedule your conferences you may mail the form in, send it to school with your student, or call 921-7420 (beginning Monday, November 9) to schedule your conferences by phone. The secretary who schedules the conferences will mail a confirmation to you with a specific time for your conference(s), or call you if the time is too short for the mail. Please keep in mind that we have a limited number of conference times, which fill quickly for some teachers, so please return your request as early as possible. Conference times will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Voicemail extensions have been included in each issue of *The Bradley Bulletin*, all of which are available on the Bradley website. In order to reach a teacher by phone, simply dial "921" and the four digit extension listed for that teacher. If you would prefer to use email, all teachers have the same email format. That format is: `firstname_lastname@hboe.org`.



I continue to be amazed by the success of our student body. As Fall slowly heads to Winter, it is a great time to reflect upon the success of the past few months. Our Fall sports teams recently completed immensely successful inaugural seasons, capped by Lauren Thai's appearance in the State Tennis Tournament and both the Boys and Girls Cross Country Teams' appearance in the Regional Cross Country Meet. Our Marching Band continued its great start with an appearance at Ohio Stadium and at one of the famed "Skull Sessions" before a recent Ohio State football game in front of more than 11,000 people! Additionally, Kayla Duncan (Freshman Trumpet), Kyle Thompson (Junior Percussionist), and David VanLaningham (Junior Percussionist) have been selected to march in this year's Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City. They will be a part of the "All American Marching Band" as selected through a taped audition. Also from our music department, Sophomore Christy Showalter was selected to the elite All State Orchestra. Finally, we are eagerly looking to our Theater Department's first performance, *Sylvia*, on November 20 and 21. I hope you will consider supporting their fine efforts!

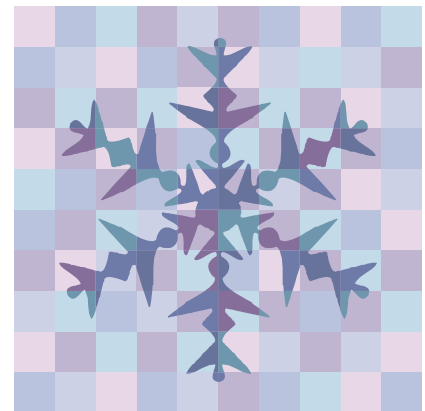

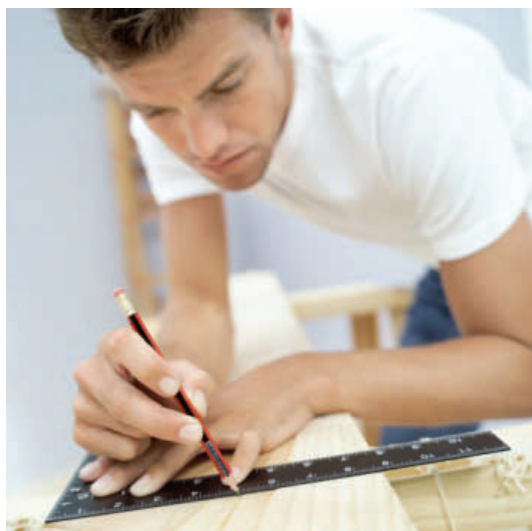
Please let us know if you have a family member in the guard, reserves or active duty so that we can better support your child here at school.
